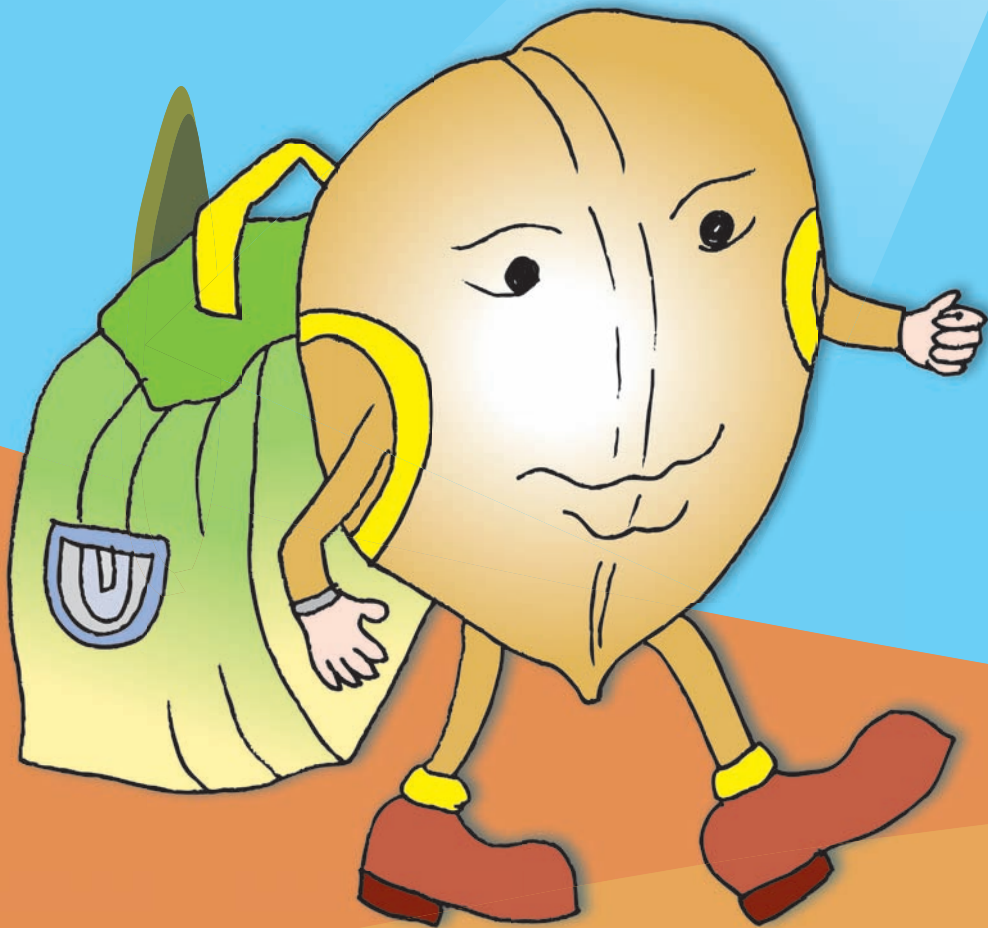

city near Naples.**

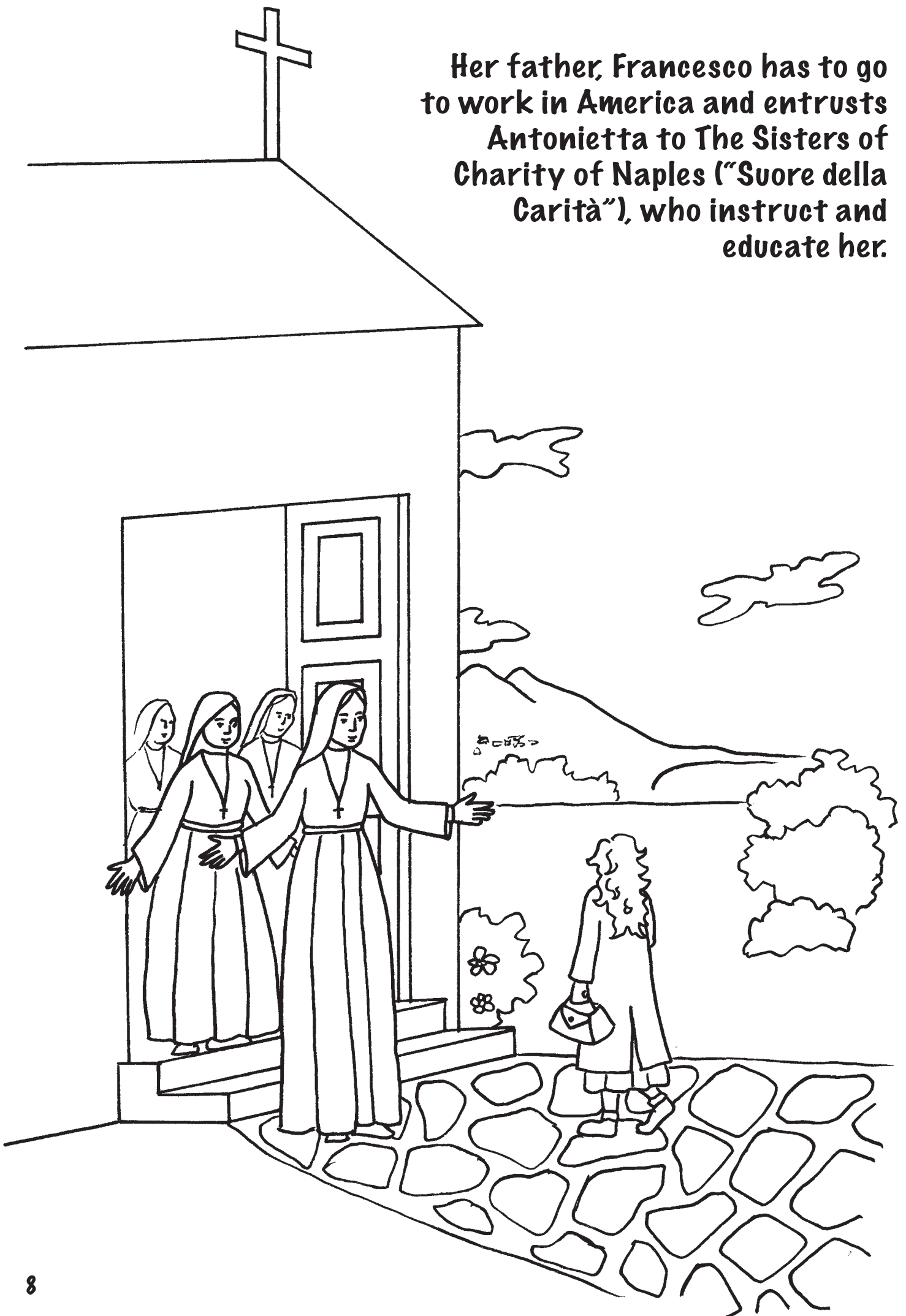


**Antonietta, living

dreams of her future.**

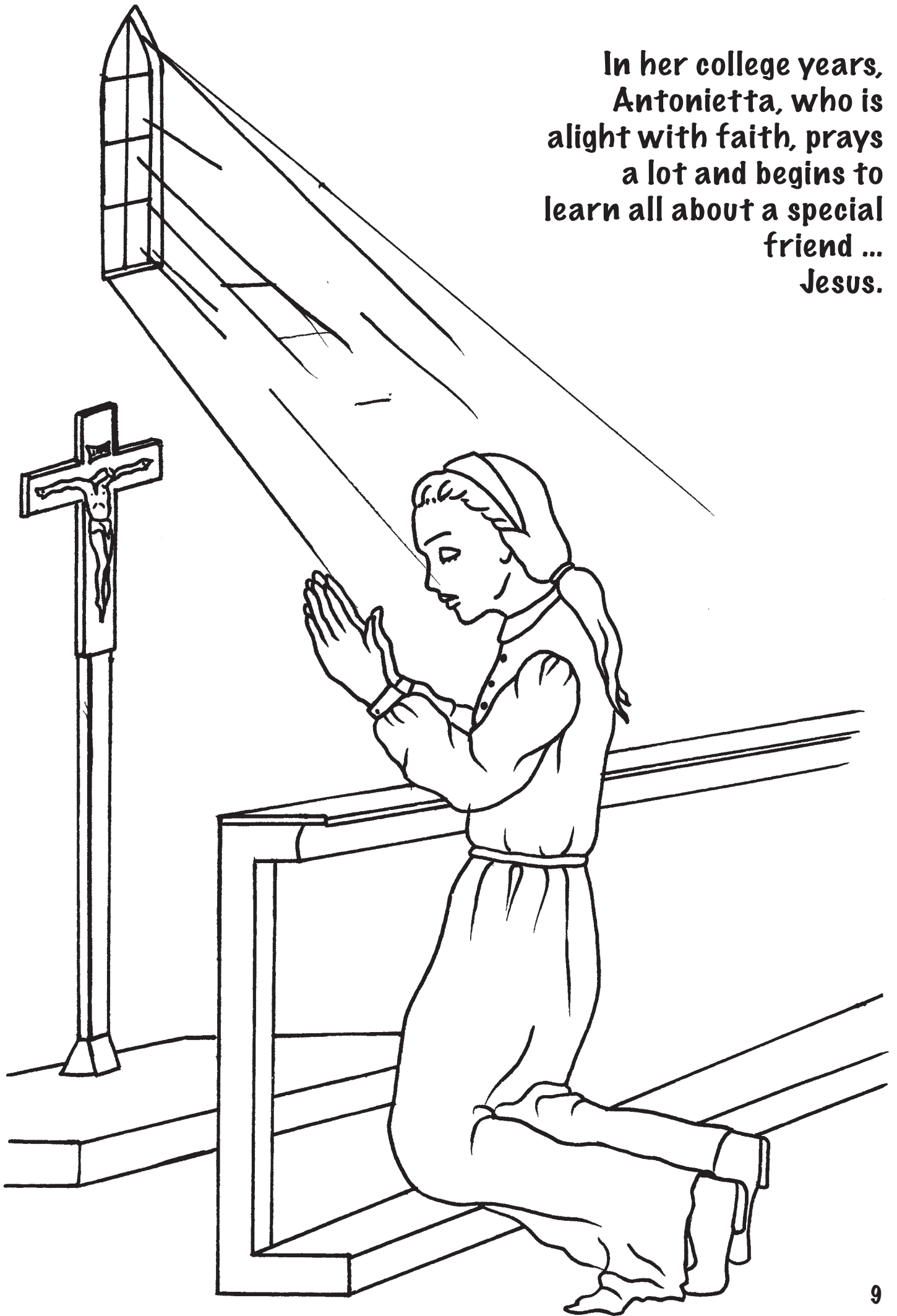




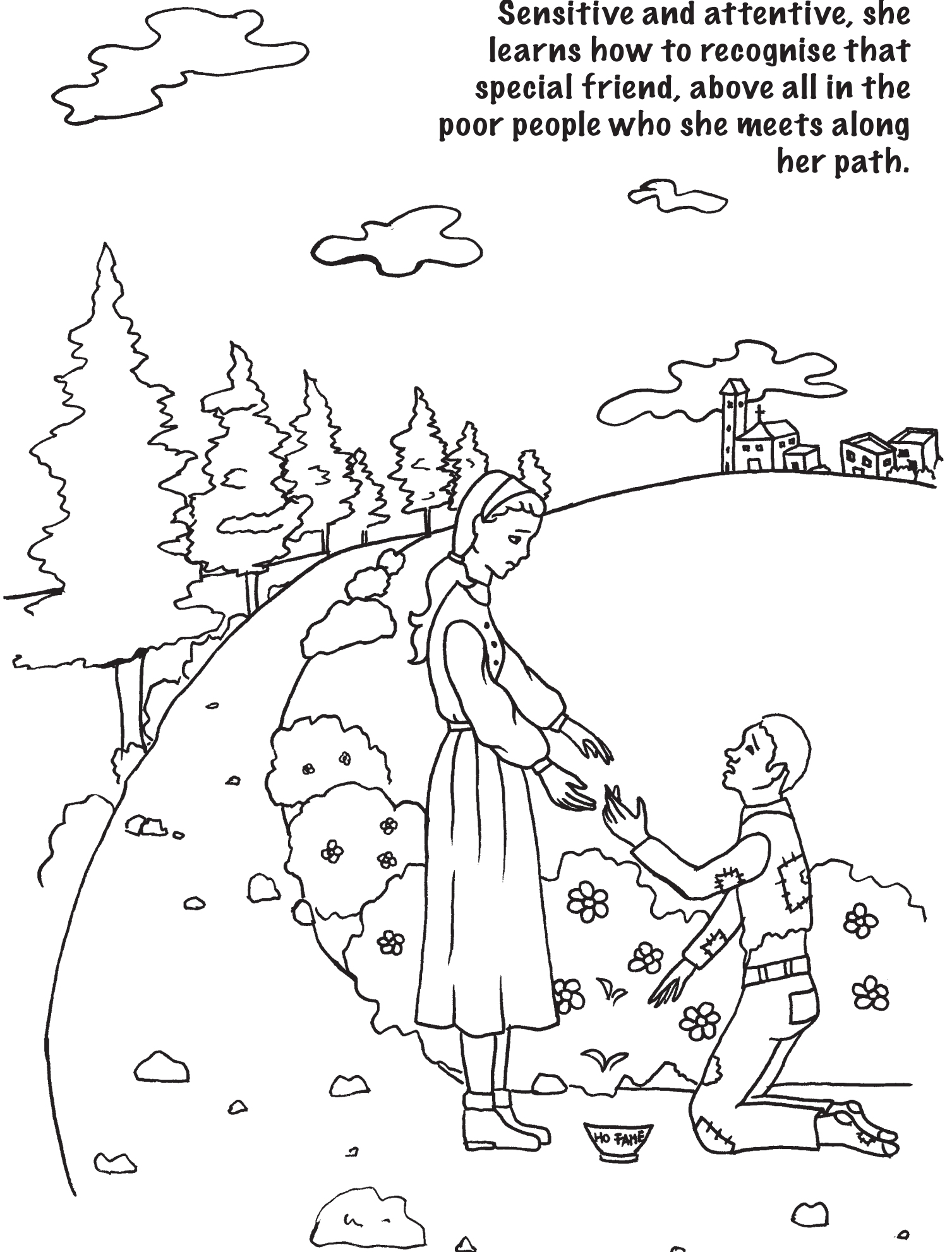
Her father, Francesco has to go to work in America and entrusts Antonietta to The Sisters of Charity of Naples ("Suore della Carità"), who instruct and educate her.

Jesus.



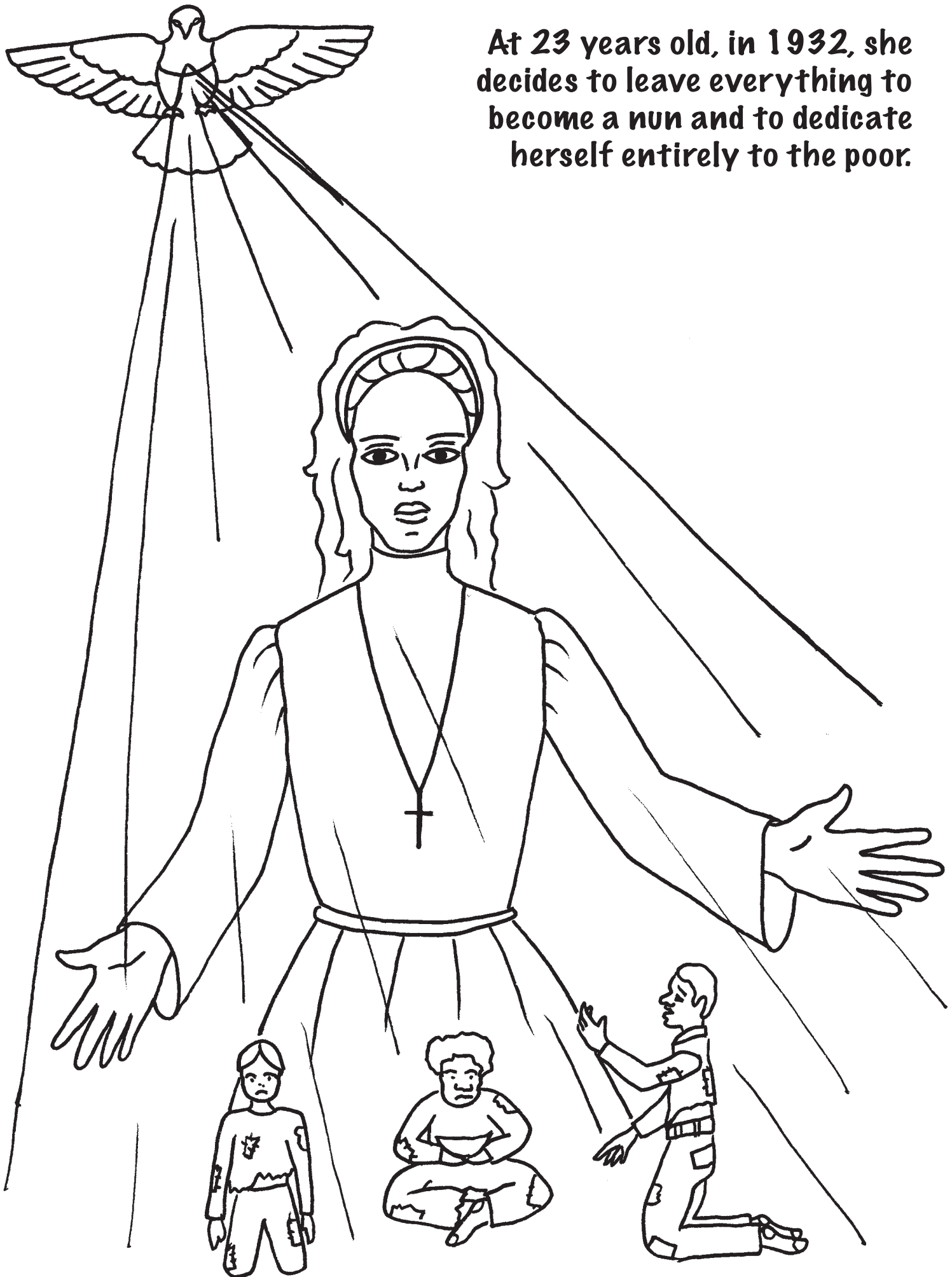
**Sensitive and attentive, she

her path.**



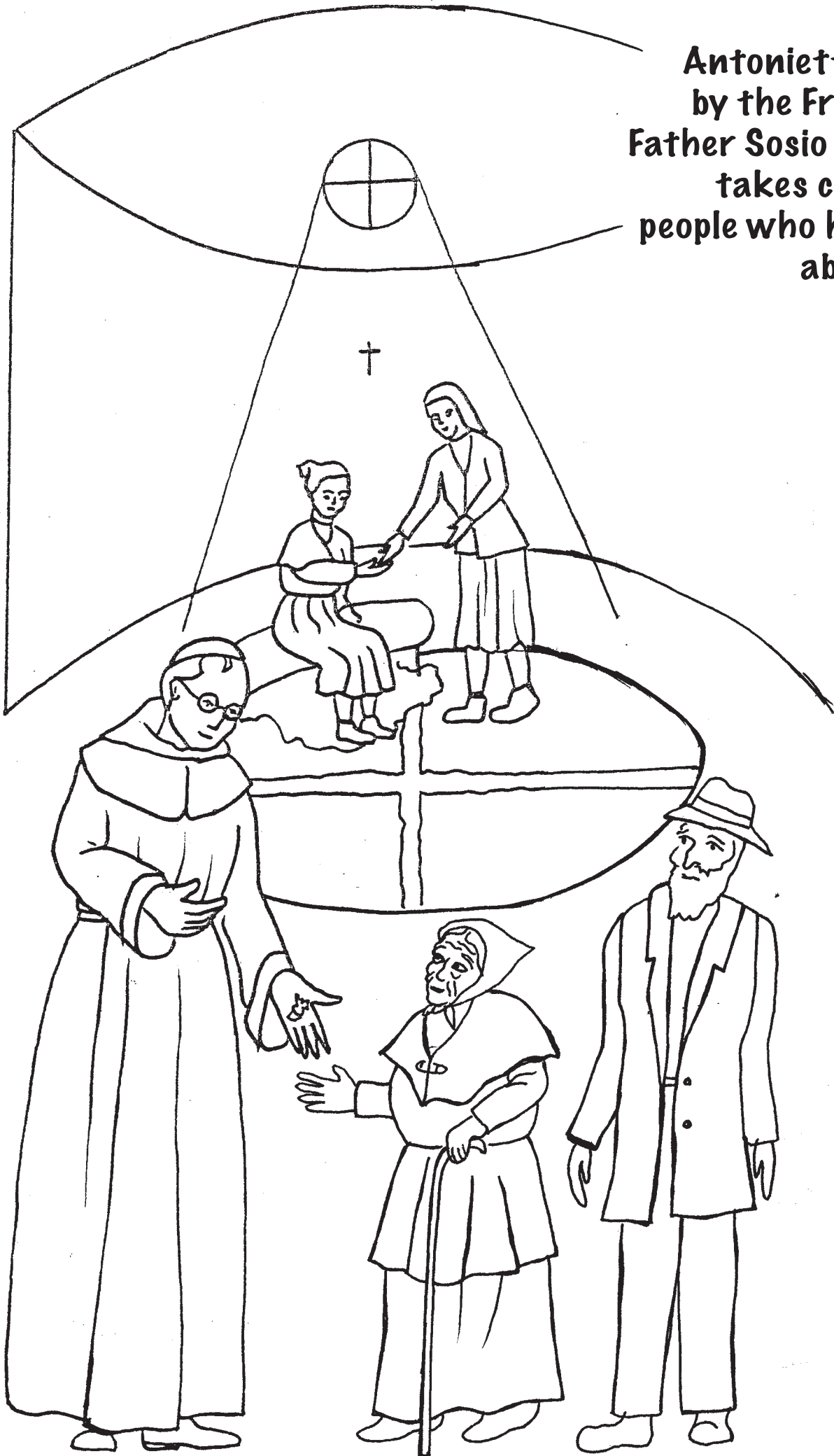
**When her father remarries,

of her vocation.**



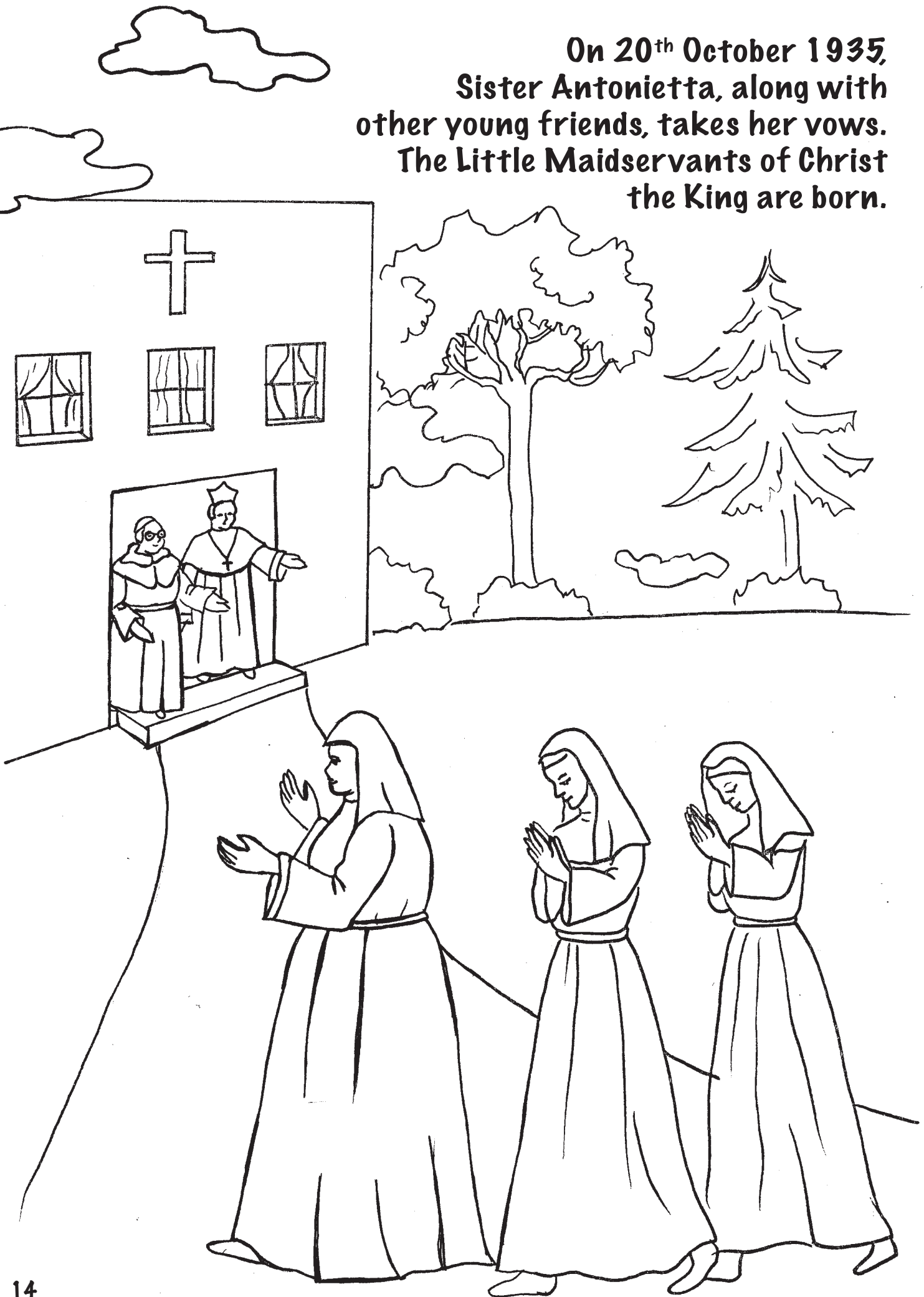
At 23 years old, in 1932, she decides to leave everything to become a nun and to dedicate herself entirely to the poor.

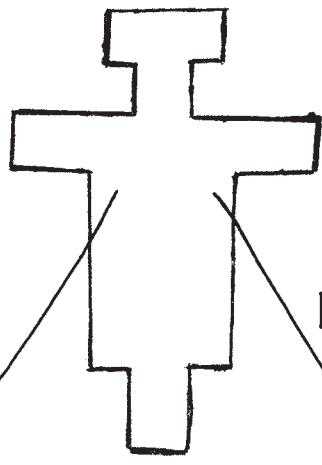


**Antonietta, guided

abandoned.**

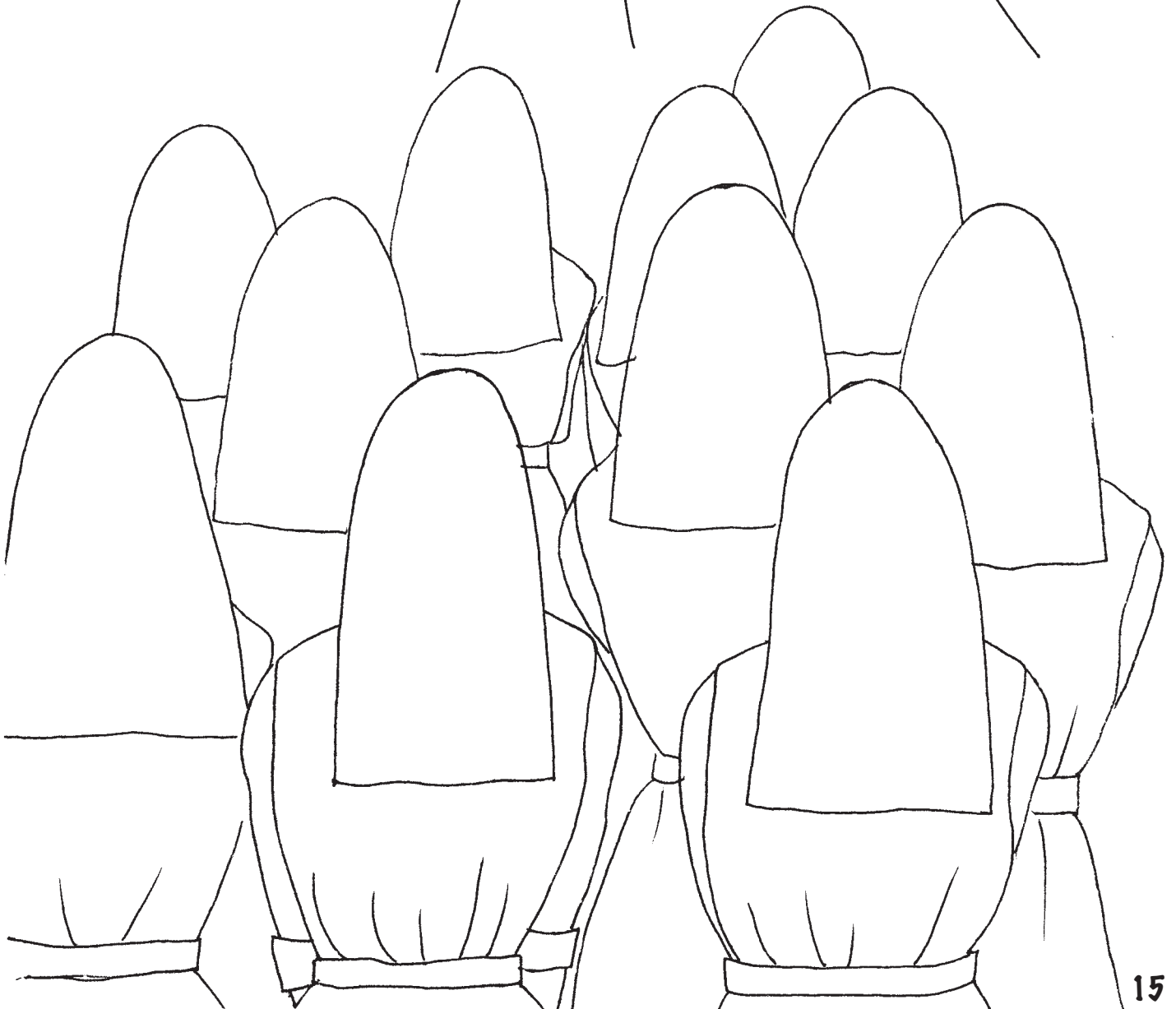


**On 20<sup>th</sup> October 1935,

in her footsteps.**

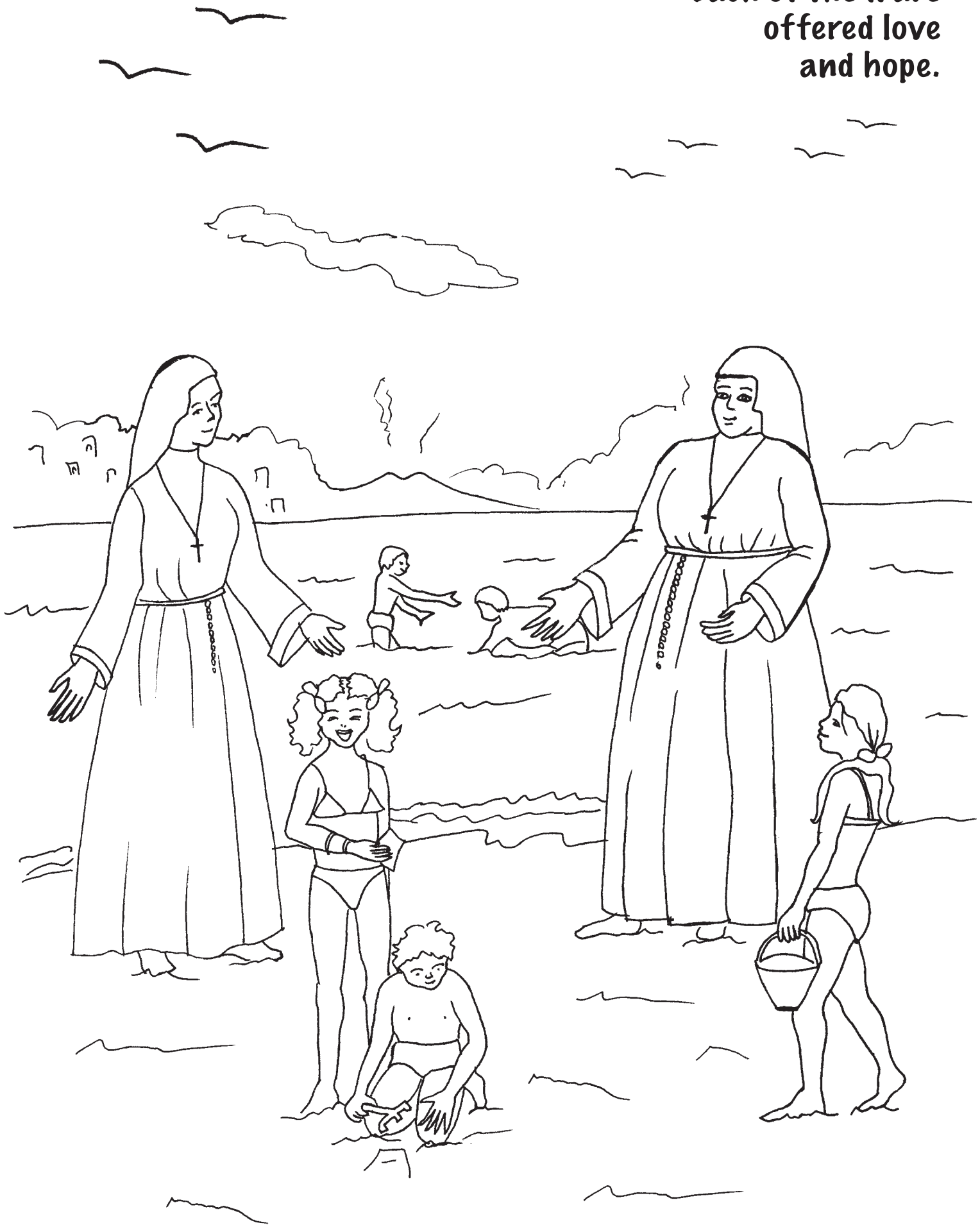




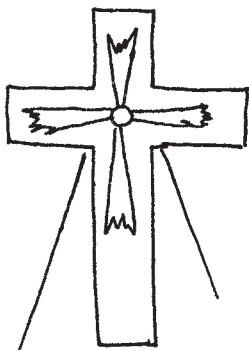
**Many poor people are helped by

of Christ the King.**

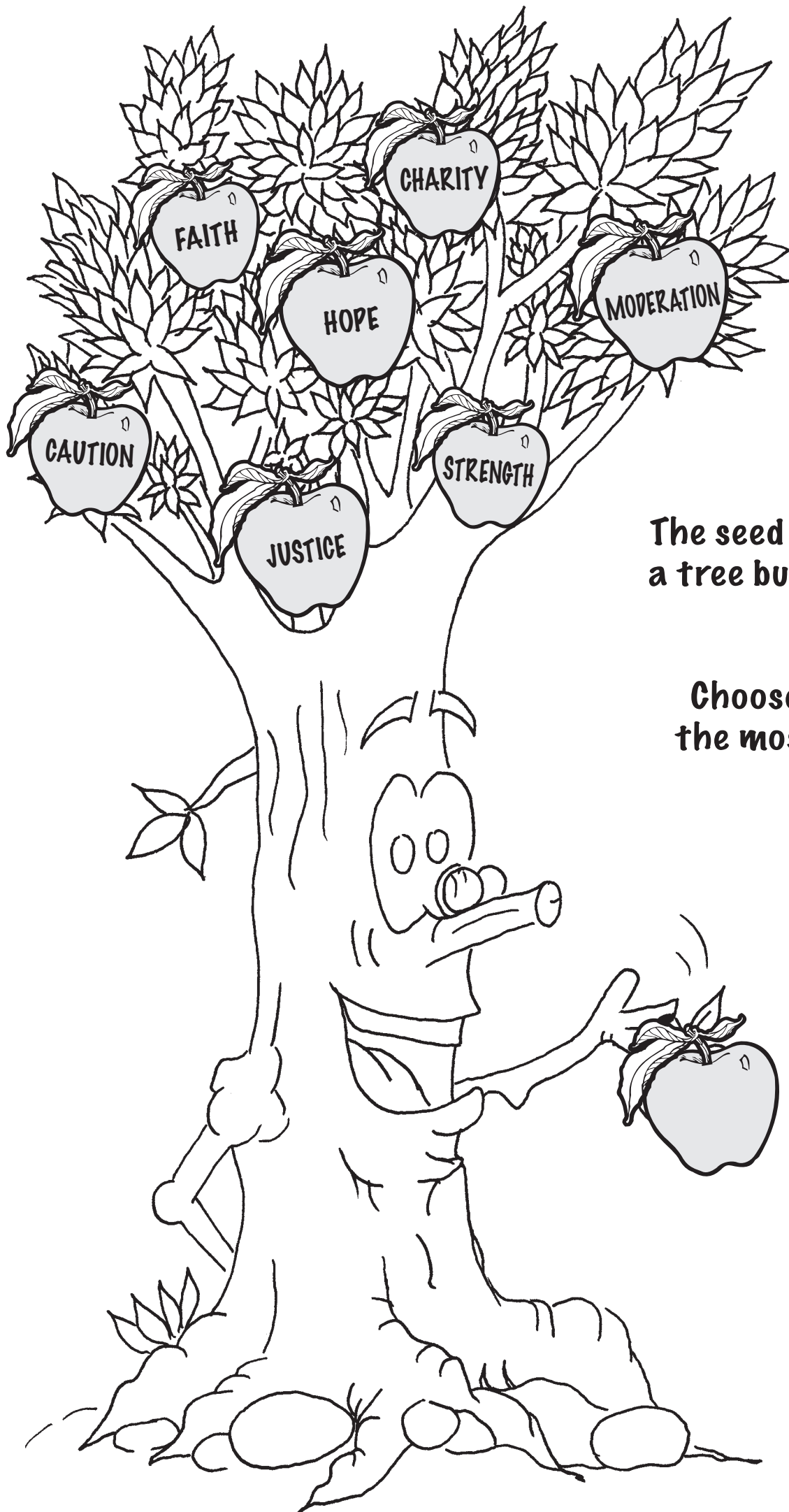


Each of them are

and in Indonesia.






**The seed has become
